Call for Volunteers for the 2019 UCR CONCOURS Event

Plans are under way to increase the size and prestige of the **UCR Concours d'Elegance** this year. The date is **Sunday, September 1**, with the location yet to be finalized but to be situated within the close surrounding areas of the GTA.

The Concours will once again feature 21 classes in the '**Peer-Judging**' format, as well as a separate '**Full Concours**' that will see the cars entered scored by qualified Concours Judges.

The Concours event gives Upper Canada Region members and guests the opportunity to display their Porsches and have them judged in context to their peers. The Concours has been one of the core events for this region since it was founded in 1976. In order to expand this year, we need **Volunteers** to step up in the following two areas:

1. We need more members to help with setting up the field and directing the cars to their specific areas for display. We have three workers now but need another three for the expansion.
2. We need more trained judges for the Judged Classes. We have five trained judges at the present time but need at least ten more.
